

Order Denying Application for Temporary
Order of Protection

Your application for a "Temporary Order of Protection" is denied. The Montana Statutes are very specific with regards to Justice Court's ability to issue restraining orders. Under the law, your application did not qualify for a restraining order for the following reason(s).

- In order to grant a restraining order, the Court must find that the applicant is in imminent danger of harm. The information provided in your application did not meet that criteria.
- In order to grant a restraining order, the Court must find that the applicant has demonstrated that he/she is in reasonable apprehension of bodily injury by a partner or family member and be a victim of assault, aggravated assault, partner-family member assault, intimidation, criminal endangerment, negligent endangerment, assault on a minor, assault with a weapon, unlawful restraint, kidnapping, aggravated kidnapping, and/or arson. The information provided in your application did not meet that criteria.
- If you have no relationship to the Respondent, then the Statutes require that you must be a victim of assault, stalking, incest, sexual assault, or sexual intercourse without consent. The information provided in your application did not meet that criteria.
- The application reflects marital, dissolution, or custody issues which are not within the jurisdiction of this Court and should be addressed by District Court
